ORDINANCE NO. 1985-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1-75 WITH REGARD TO COLLECTION FEES FOR THE COLLECTION OF REFUSE WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Goldsboro Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the Authority of the same, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1-75, Section 8, enacted and ordained on the 10th day of March, 1975, by the Borough of Goldsboro is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

SECTION 8: COLLECTION FEES

A. A monthly collection fee shall be charged to every real property owner who owns improved real property within the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, for each parcel of improved real property, at such rates as the Borough Council shall from time to time establish by resolution.

B. The monthly collection fee shall apply to each parcel of improved real property within the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, whether a property is used for residential purposes, vacation purposes, seasonal occupancy purposes, business purposes, or any other purpose.

C. In addition to the aforesaid monthly collection fee the owner of improved real property shall pay an additional monthly collection fee for any additional household unit, business, organization, or any other occupant residing in,

occupying, or using the said improved real property.

D. It is the intent of this Ordinance that the number of collection fees charged to the owners of improved real property within the Borough of Goldsboro shall equal the number of parcels of improved real property together with the number of each additional household unit, business, organization or any other occupant of any such improved real property located within the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania.

(B) E. In the event the owner of a parcel of real property within Goldsboro Borough being used for commercial purposes desires to dispose of refuse created by the commercial use through a private refuse collector, such property owner shall present to Borough Council the proposal for the alternate disposal and if such property owner assures Borough Council that the provisions of Ordinance No. 1-75 shall be complied with, that the Borough's refuse collector will not be used for refuse created by the commercial use, and establishes that the proposed alternate method is adequate for the disposal of the refuse used in the commercial use, the Borough Council may abate the monthly collection fee for the property being used for the commercial use for so long as the commercial use does not use the Borough refuse collector, and for so long as the proposed alternate method of disposal is actually used, provided, however, that the provisions of Ordinance No. 1-75 are not violated by the property owner. In the event the property owner of the commercial use no longer uses the alternative method or uses the Borough's refuse collector or

violates any of the provisions of Ordinance No. 1-75 the monthly collection fee shall be immediately charged to the property by the Borough.

**SECTION 2:** In all other respects the aforementioned Ordinance No. 1-75 is hereby reaffirmed and re-enacted by the the Borough of Goldsboro.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
