RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GOLDSBORO BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO EXERCISE THE OPTION GRANTED TO IT TO ASSUME OWNERSHIP OF ALL RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST TO, OPERATION AND BENEFITS OF THE COMMUNITY WATER COMPANY OWNED AND OPERATED BY SHELLEY'S WATER COMPANY AND THE HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION OF SHELLEY'S RIVERVIEW DEVELOPMENT LOCATED WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Borough was granted the option to assume the operation, ownership and benefits of the Water Company by the covenants creating the development of Shelley's Riverview; and

WHEREAS, the action of the Borough Council was approved by a majority vote of the Council Members on December 8, 1997;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Goldsboro Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, that it hereby exercises its option to assume ownership of all right, title and interest to the operation and the benefits of the Shelley's Water Company, including but not by way of limitation, all physical assets, real and personal, components of the system, including but not limited to lines, mains, wells, stand pipes, accounts receivable, legal and equitable liens and judgments; and rights-of-way and easements.

REPEAL. All other resolutions or parts of any other resolution which are inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Resolution is for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections


or parts of this Resolution. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included therein.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective on the first day of January, 1998.


