

A N O R D I N A N C E .

Fixing a method of lighting the streets and highways of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and providing for the making of contracts for that purpose.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that henceforth the streets and highways of said borough shall be lighted at the expense of said borough during the night, or such portion of the night as the Town Council of said borough shall from time to time by resolution prescribe, by means of electricity, gas, gasoline, kerosene or other system of illumination, as said Town Council may from time to time prescribe.

Section 2. The said Town Council shall make contracts for the ~~lighting of the streets and highways~~ of said borough as aforesaid, with any individual or corporation desiring to furnish light for such purpose, upon the best terms obtainable for the kind of light prescribed by said Town Council, but no such contract shall be for a longer term than ten years.

Section 3. Said contract for the lighting of the streets and highways of said borough shall be executed in the corporate name of the Borough of Goldsboro by the Chief Burgess of said borough, and the Secretary of the said Town Council shall affix thereunto the corporate seal of the Borough of Goldsboro, attested by the said secretary.
