A N O R D I N A N C E

Be it ordained and is hereby ordained-That The Northern Central Railroad Company, be and is hereby granted permission to erect its Structure Poles Nos. 1100 and 1101 at a position of 29 feet and 6 inches (instead of 31 ft) from their center line of right of way as shown by print dated, July 1, 1937, prepared by E. H. B.*L.F.V. checked by H. A. B. " Entitled, Easement to be acquired from the Borough of Goldsboro by the Northern Central Railroad Company."

Provided--The said Northern Central Railroad Company erect a 6 inch cement curb, being of a uniform width at the top, flush with the present surface of Railroad Street, beginning at a point at the Southeast junction of Court Alley and the line to be established by the western surface of the above mentioned No. 1100 and 1101 structure poles, said point to be the Railroad Street side of said curb; thence running in a Northern direction for a distance of 600 feet parallel with the center line of aforesaid right of way and the east side of Railroad Street to a Point.

Provided further that said curb have outlets for the present existing water outlets now crossing Railroad Street, (being two in number).--Provided further that the Northern Central Railroad Company erect a Standard Guard 30 inches high with two stranded cables on the top of the curb or the east side of said curb for the entire distance of the curb, said guard posts and cable to be painted with aluminum paint and provided further that the Northern Central Railroad Company, fill, grade, macadamize and otherwise improve said Railroad Street between the present Macadamized surface and the proposed curb.
