AN ORDINANCE.

Signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the Borough of Goldsboro, County of York and State of Pennsylvania, to increase the indebtedness of said Borough for the purpose of purchasing a fire engine, hose and fire fighting equipment, providing for the holding of an election therefor and authorizing the corporate authorities to make the necessary announcements of said election and do all other acts and things incident thereto.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Goldsboro and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authorities of the same, that the corporated authorities of the Borough of Goldsboro hereby signify and express their desire to increase the bonded indebtedness of the Borough of Goldsboro by the amount of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), for the purpose of purchasing a fire engine, hose and fire fighting equipment.

Section 2. That a public election be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be held at the usual hours and places on the 2nd day of *May* 1939, for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors of the said Borough for the increase of the bonded indebtedness of the Borough by the amount and for the purpose aforesaid, and the corporate authorities are hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary announcements of said election through their chief burgess and do all other acts and things incident thereto.
