

An Ordinance

Fixing the tax rate for the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania.

The Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1, That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1957 at the rate of nine (9) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation of real estate, the revenue derived therefrom to be used for general Borough purposes.

Section 2, All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Notice of Reenactment of the ordinance of February 9, 1953, of the Goldsboro Borough, York County Pennsylvania., imposing a per Capita tax on Adult Residents of the Borough.

In accordance with a resolution passed by the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, at its regular meeting Monday, February 11, 1957, notice is hereby given that the Ordinance adopted on February 9, 1953, imposing a tax of \$5.00 on every residence of the Borough twenty-one (21) years or more of age, under authority of the Act of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania, approved June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145, as amended, has been reenacted without substantial change, and the same tax is hereby imposed for the fiscal year 1957.

The rate of tax on assessed real estate be nine (9) mills and the rate of per capita tax be Two and fifty cents (\$2.50) on every resident of the Borough for the year 1957.
