ORDINANCE NO. 1-70

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
LIMITATION OF PARKING ALONG THE
STREETS, ALLEYS AND HIGHWAYS IN
THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania may, in its discretion, limit parking of vehicles along the streets, alleys and highways in the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2: No Parking signs shall be erected in those areas so established as No Parking Zones by the said Borough Council.

SECTION 3: Any person convicted before a Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Goldsboro, or the District Justice of the Peace, shall be liable to the penalties set forth in the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania for such violation.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be effective the 9th day of June, 1970.

SECTION 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, clause, sentence, part or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall not effect or impair any of the sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance.

THEREFORE, this Ordinance is hereby enacted and adopted
by the Borough of Goldsboro, this 8th day of June, 1970.
