

ORDINANCE NO. 3-75

BARKING DOG ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BARKING DOGS DURING CERTAIN HOURS OF THE NIGHT AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE OWNER OF THE DOG FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

Be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the Authority of the same, that:

SECTION 1: No owner or other person responsible to the owner shall confine any dog in any building, structure, open air enclosure, yard or other outside area within the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, where the barking of the dog may disturb the quiet of the neighborhood after the hour of 12:00 midnight, or before the hour of 6:00 A.M.

SECTION 2: Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, after a hearing before a District Magistrate of York County, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each offense. Each day's continuance of the violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
