

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY FIREARM, EXCEPT IN THE NECESSARY DEFENSE OF PERSON OR PROPERTY, WITHIN 150 FEET OF ANY STRUCTURE WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Authority of the same, as follows:

No person shall, except in necessary defense or person or property, fire or discharge any firearm within 150 feet of any structure within the Borough of Goldsboro. Any person who shall violate this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$100.00 and cost of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and cost, to be imprisoned for a period not to exceed 10 days.
