

ORDINANCE NO. 78-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 77-1
(REQUIRING SNOW AND ICE TO BE REMOVED
FROM SIDEWALKS)

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough Council
of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it
is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, as follows, to
wit:

SECTION 1

Section I of Ordinance No. 77-1 (An Ordinance requiring
owners, occupants, and tenants of property to remove snow and
ice from abutting sidewalks; prescribing the conditions under
which snow and ice may be removed by the Borough at the
expense of the owner, occupant, or tenant of the property; and
prescribing penalties for violation) is hereby amended to read
as follows: "The owner, occupant, or tenant of every property
fronting upon or along side of any street or alley within the
Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, is hereby
required to remove or cause to be removed from all of the side-
walks and walkways in front of or along side of such property
all snow or ice thereon fallen or formed within twenty-four
hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or formed. The
snow or ice shall be removed to a width of not less than two
feet and shall not be placed in any street, alley, gutter,
crosswalk, or cartway within the Borough of Goldsboro, so as to
prohibit or restrict travel thereon. Provided, the owner of a
property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements
of this Section where such property is occupied by such owner
or is unoccupied; the tenant or occupier thereof, where such
property is occupied by such tenant or occupier only; and the
owner thereof where the property is a mutiple business or
mutiple dwelling property, occupied by more than one tenant or
occupier."

SECTION 2

In all other aspects the aforesaid Ordinance No. 77-1 is

hereby ratified and re-affirmed.
