

ORDINANCE 81-2

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING TREES BUSHES AND OTHER VEGETATION TO BE TRIMMED SO AS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE SUPPLYING OF ELECTRICITY BY THE BOROUGH TO ITS CUSTOMERS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Goldsboro Borough, York County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough of Goldsboro is hereby empowered to trim or cut any overhanging tree, other trees, bushes, or other vegetation, so as to provide a minimum of five feet clearance from the said trees, bushes or other vegetation to any wires, cables, poles, or other equipment of the Goldsboro Electric Power Company.

SECTION 2: Within ten days after notice from the Borough to a property owner, that trees, bushes or other vegetation must be cut or trimmed, as required in Section 1 of this Ordinance, the owner of any property upon which such trees, bushes or vegetation is growing shall have the said trees, bushes or vegetation trimmed or cut in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance. The owner shall notify the Borough of the date and time when the trimming and cutting is to occur in order that the same may be supervised by an employee of the Borough. In the event that the owner of such property, upon which the trees, bushes or other vegetation is growing, shall neglect, refuse or fail to trim or cut the same within ten days from notice of the Borough, the Borough may cause the same to be done at the expense of the Borough and the Borough shall collect such expense and an additional penalty of ten percent from the owner of such property.

SECTION 3: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00 and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty days. Each day's continuance of a violation, after notice thereof, shall constitute a separate offense. The penalty imposed under this section may be in addition to any expenses and penalties in connection therewith authorized to be collected under the preceding section of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective on the 9th day of February, 1981, and shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended or rescinded by the Borough Council of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania.
