

ORDINANCE NO. 81-5

AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING A CERTAIN ALLEY SITUTATE
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO BOROUGH, YORK
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BEING KNOWN AS EAST KAHLER
AVENUE.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Goldsboro
Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted
and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1:

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance
the following alley which has remained unopened for a period of
ten (10) years or longer is hereby cancelled by the Borough of
Goldsboro and removed as a public street from the official Borough
Street Map:

- A. East Kahler Avenue, from the east side of
South York Street east approximately 100 feet.

SECTION 2:

This Ordinance shall be effective as of the
forty first day following its enactment.




