ORDINANCE NO. 1990-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FINES AND  
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF GOLDSBORO  
BOROUGH ORDINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance any person violating any ordinance of the Borough of Goldsboro shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$600.00 and in default of payment thereof be sentenced to no more than ninety (90) days imprisonment in the York County Prison.

SECTION 2: Any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with the Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same conflicts with this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

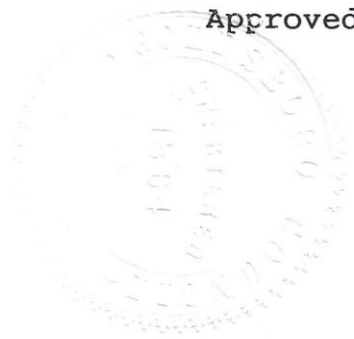

The Ordinance is entitled as follows:

A summary of the Ordinance is as follows:

The Ordinance establishes a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$600.00, and in default of payment thereof, a sentence of no more than ninety (90) days imprisonment in the York County Prison for the violation of any Borough Ordinance. Prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with Ordinance No. 1990-2 are repealed. The Ordinance is effective upon its adoption.
