

**GOLDSBORO BOROUGH**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1995 - 4**

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING BOROUGH MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF DATED BOROUGH RECORDS AT HIS/HER DISCRETION.

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The manager of the Borough of Goldsboro, (presently Lee Fishel) shall have the responsibility to dispose of dated Borough Records. The disposal of such dated and/or antiquated records shall be at the sole discretion of the Borough Manager.

**SECTION 2:** It is the intention of the Borough Council that each section or portion of any section of this Ordinance shall be a separate provision and all shall be independent of all other provisions herein, and it is further the intention of the Borough Council that if any section or portion of any Section shall be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid, illegal or unenforceable by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining sections or parts thereof of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional, invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision not been included herein.

**SECTION 3:** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent

of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be and become effective immediately upon its adoption.
