

ORDINANCE 2000-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO MAINTAIN THE 1999 MILLAGE RATE OF THE REAL ESTATE TAX ASSESSMENT FOR THE YEAR 2000.

WHEREAS, the Council of Goldsboro Borough is empowered to enact a tax on the real estate of the Borough of Goldsboro; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro desires to maintain the millage rate of tax assessments in the Borough of Goldsboro;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of Goldsboro Borough as follows: Goldsboro Borough hereby establishes the millage rate for the Borough of Goldsboro for the year 2000 to ~~.000725.~~ .000750


REPEAL: All other Ordinances or parts of any other Ordinance which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance 2000-1 shall become effective on the first day of January, 2000.



ENACTED AND ORDAINED, this 29 day of December, 1999, by Borough Council of Goldsboro Borough.


