

***GOLDSBORO BOROUGH
ORDINANCE NO. 2000-2***

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO MAINTAIN THE 2000
MILLAGE RATE OF THE REAL ESTATE TAX ASSESSMENT FOR THE
YEAR 2001.**

WHEREAS, The Council of Goldsboro Borough is empowered to enact a tax on the real estate of the Borough of Goldsboro; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro desires to maintain the millage rate of tax assessments in the Borough of Goldsboro; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of Goldsboro Borough as follows:

Millage Rate: Goldsboro Borough hereby establishes the millage rate for the Borough of Goldsboro for the year 2001 to ~~.000725~~. *000750*

Repeal: All other Ordinances or parts of any other Ordinance which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Effective Date: This Ordinance 2000-2 shall become effective on the first day of January 2001.

Severability: If any sentence, clause, section, or part of the Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof had not been included therein.
