

***GOLDSBORO BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE NO. 2009-4***

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO MAINTAIN THE 2009 MILLAGE  
RATE OF THE REAL ESTATE TAX ASSESSMENT FOR THE YEAR 2010.**

*WHEREAS*, The Council of Goldsboro Borough is empowered to enact a tax on the real estate of the Borough of Goldsboro; and

*WHEREAS*, the Borough of Goldsboro desires to maintain the millage rate of tax assessments in the Borough of Goldsboro; and

*NOW, THEREFORE*, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of Goldsboro Borough as follows:

*Tax Levy:* Goldsboro Borough hereby levies a Real Estate Tax for general borough purposes upon the assessed value of real estate situate in the borough pursuant to Section 1302 of the Borough Code, 53 P.S. §46302.

*Millage Rate:* Goldsboro Borough hereby establishes the Real Estate Tax millage rate for the Borough of Goldsboro for the year 2010 at 0.75 mills.

*Repeal:* All other Ordinances or parts of any other Ordinance which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


*Effective Date:* This Ordinance shall be come effective on the first day of January 2010.


*Severability:* If any sentence, clause, section, or part of the Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof had not been included therein.
