ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), PART 2 (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SIGNAGE FOR STOPPED INTERSECTIONS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Part 2 (Traffic Regulations) of the Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Goldsboro (the "Borough") establishes, *inter alia*, signage for stopped intersections (the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough deems it necessary to amend and update the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. Amendment to Stop Street. Section 15-202(1) (Stop Intersections Established) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following:

| Stop Street | Intersection or Through Street | Direction of Travel |
|--------------------|---|----------------------------|
| Frazer Street | Railroad Crossing | East and West |

2. Amendment to Fine. Section 15-202(2) (Stop Intersections Established) of the Ordinance is hereby deleted and replaced to read as follows:

2. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine as provided pursuant to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as amended, 75 Pa. C.S. § 101 *et seq.*


3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Borough of Goldsboro hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, and phrases be declared unconstitutional or unenforceable.

4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

5. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.


