

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES FOR
MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDED
BY THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO

Be it resolved by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro,
York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the
same as follows:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro operates a municipal
system of electric service to its residents and whereas, it is essential to
the functioning of the municipality that rates be established and adopted for
those who receive the benefits of the said municipal service.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the
Borough of Goldsboro as follows:

1. Effective the 15th day of December, 1973, the following
rate schedule shall be adopted by Goldsboro Borough.

It is further provided that if the Metropolitan Edison Company shall obtain approval to increase the rate which it presently charges, the Municipal Electric Service System, the rate schedule as set forth in paragraph 1 above shall automatically be increased to compensate for any such increase in charge by Metropolitan Edison Company and that such increase shall require no further action by Borough Council.
