

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES FOR DUSK  
TO DAWN LIGHTS PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL  
ELECTRIC SERVICES OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDS-  
BORO

Be it resolved by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro operates a municipal system of electric service to its residents and whereas, it is essential to the functioning of the municipality that rates be established and adopted for those who receive the benefits of the said municipal service.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro provides dusk to dawn lights as a service to its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the Borough of Goldsboro as follows:

1. Effective the 14 day of OCT. , 1974, the following rate schedule for dusk to dawn lights shall be adopted by the Borough of Goldsboro:

Six Dollars (\$6.00) per month for each dusk  
to dawn light.

2. It is further provided that if the cost of maintaining services and providing electricity for the said dusk to dawn lights shall increase, the said Borough Council may, at any regular scheduled monthly Borough Council meeting, increase the rate schedule as set forth in Paragraph 1 above to compensate for any such increase in operating expenses.

The above and foregoing Resolution having been processed in accordance with law is hereby sustained this 14 day of OCT., 1974.
