A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY  
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of  
Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby resolved by  
the authority of the same as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS a dire situation exists within the Borough  
of Goldsboro, due to the severe and inclement weather during  
this winter season, and

WHEREAS, a Declaration of a State of Emergency has  
been issued by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,  
and,


WHEREAS, the same circumstances which required the  
Governor to issue a Declaration of a State of Emergency within  
the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, exists within the Borough of  
Goldsboro.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Borough of  
Goldsboro that a Declaration of a State of Emergency within the  
Borough of Goldsboro be and is hereby issued and all emergency  
measures and procedures are hereby declared to be in effect  
until such time as terminated by the Mayor of the Borough of  
Goldsboro.

of Goldsboro.


