
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same that:

WHEREAS, the Borough has suffered damage to Borough property, and,


WHEREAS, in an attempt to safeguard Borough property and eliminate damage to Borough property, the Borough Council has determined that a reward should be offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of persons damaging the Borough property,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro that in accordance with the Pennsylvania Borough Code, Section 1202 (73) a reward in the amount of fifty (\$50.00) dollars is hereby offered to any person or persons supplying information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons causing damage to Borough property.

The foregoing Resolution having been processed in accordance with law is hereby sustained this day of , 1978, at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro.


