

RESOLUTION 1-80

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, IN CONJUNCTION WITH CERTAIN NEIGHBORING MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE FEASIBILITY OF COOPERATIVE POLICE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, is desirous of having a detailed study of law enforcement services conducted in the Borough, in conjunction with neighboring municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Consulting Services Division of the Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is willing, under certain conditions, to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of developing cooperative police services, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Goldsboro hereby appoints Kenneth E. Myers as its representative on a Police Study Committee which will serve as liaison to DCA project staff and which will perform other functions determined by the Committee to be necessary for the successful completion of the study, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Goldsboro agree to permit access to municipal records and personnel to the degree determined to be necessary by DCA study personnel, and

THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the governing body of the Borough of Goldsboro that the Municipal Consulting Services Division of the Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be authorized to conduct a study of law enforcement services in the Borough of Goldsboro, in conjunction with neighboring municipalities

for the purpose of determining the feasibility of cooperative police services.
