RESOLUTION 2-80

Whereas, the Environmental Protection Agency, an agency of the Federal Government, has initiated a program of environmental monitoring to provide reliable data in determining presence of radiation in our environment during the continuing clean-up operation of the Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Facility.

And Whereas, this Borough Council is extremely grateful for the actions taken to assure a safe environment through the continuous monitoring program.

However, because of concerns of some residents with regard to the location of one such air sampling unit used in the continuous monitoring program. Said air sampling unit in question being located at the site of 26 East Broadway Street (Miller Residence) in the Borough of Goldsboro.

And whereas, past publicity concerning this matter has suggested improprieties even though this Council feels no such improprieties exist.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Goldsboro Borough Council strongly suggests, if it is at all feasible, to relocate said air sampling unit as soon as practical. Such location as Council suggests would be the Borough Hall Property located on North York Street. Be advised, such a change would place this unit on local government property. A fenced area to the rear of this property would supply security for the unit. Goldsboro Borough will in good faith supply adequate electrical hook-up for appropriate operation of the unit. However, Monthly electrical usage would be billed at the appropriate rate.

Whereas, such a change would alleviate any questions of improprieties in the minds of those few individuals who continually insist that such improprieties exist.
