

RESOLUTION NO. 1 of 1981

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE "GOLDSBORO EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR A RADIATION INCIDENT OCCURING AT THE THREE MILE ISLAND NUCLEAR FACILITY" AS THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same that:

WHEREAS: the Borough of Goldsboro has determined that it is necessary for the protection of the public safety and welfare for the adoption of an Emergency Management Plan for the Borough of Goldsboro,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro that a plan entitled "Goldsboro Emergency Operations Plan for a Radiation Incident Occuring at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Facility" is hereby adopted as the Emergency Management Plan for the Borough of Goldsboro.

The foregoing Resolution having been passed in accordance with law is hereby sustained this 9th day of March, 1981, at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro.
