RESOLUTION NO. 1 of 1982

A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO  
TO APPLY FOR RECREATION PROJECT ASSISTANCE  
FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:

WHEREAS, Act #443 of the 1967 Session of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania provides for grants to municipalities for the acquisition and development of park and recreation lands; and

WHEREAS, Borough of Goldsboro desires to develop Goldsboro Community Park; which land is to be held and used as a permanent park for recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for developing the said land is \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the local share of the project cost is \$15,000.00, said share being immediately available for the purposes herein applied for; and

WHEREAS, the estimated annual cost for maintenance of said land and proposed facilities is \$3,000.00, said amount to be budgeted annually,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, that the President and Secretary of Borough Council are hereby authorized to execute such application and file an application with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Community Affairs for the purpose of obtaining grant

funds for the development of Goldsboro Community Park.


