

GOLDSBORO BOROUGH RESOLUTION 85-2.

Be it RESOLVED, that the Goldsboro Council of York County hereby requests a Community Facilities grant of \$50,000 from the Department of Commerce of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to be used for construction of a waste water collection system.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Goldsboro Council does hereby designate Earl M. Corman as the official to execute all documents and agreements between the Goldsboro Council and the Pennsylvania Department of Commerce to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Goldsboro Council does hereby irrevocably pledge the required matching share of \$ ^{540,100} 540,100. toward fulfillment of the Community Facilities Project grant.
