RESOLUTION 4-87

IN SUPPORT OF STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, Federal Revenue Sharing was discontinued by Congress at the end of 1986; and,

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania communities have has suffered a serious loss of revenue which has resulted in reduced funding available to maintain previous levels of municipal services; and,


WHEREAS, It is vital that additional funding be obtained, other than placing additional burden on property owners, to continue at the minimum level of services demanded by residents; and,

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of Pennsylvania continues to mandate additional programs and levels of service which places a greater strain on limited local taxing powers and other sources of funding; and,

NOW, Therefore be it resolved that we strongly urge the Pennsylvania General Assembly to enact legislation providing State Financial Assistance to be distributed to all municipalities based upon the formula previously used under the Federal Revenue Sharing program, and that the State funding level be as close to the prior Federal level as possible.
