CONCURRING IN THE RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF YORK, PENNSYLVANIA,
DESIGNATING YORK COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT
CORPORATION AS THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR
THE COUNTY OF YORK IN ALL MATTERS RELEVANT TO AND FOR
ALL PURPOSES OF THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE
LAW.

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated September 11, 1985, the Board of
Commissioners of the County of York, Pennsylvania has designated the York
County Industrial Development Corporation, One Market Way East, York,
Pennsylvania, 17401, as the Industrial Development Agency to represent the
County of York in all matters relevant to and for all purposes of the
Industrial Assistance law; and

WHEREAS, York County Industrial Development Corporation may only
act as the Industrial Development Agency for the County of York upon
concurrence in the above stated Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of
the County of York by the governing bodies of the City of York and
Borough/~~Township~~ of GOLDSBORO within the County
having in the aggregate over 50 per centum of the population of said
County; and

WHEREAS, the Council/~~Board of Commissioners/Board of Supervisors~~ of
GOLDSBORO BOROUGH desire that the York County
Industrial Development Corporation act as the Industrial Development Agency
for the County of York, Pennsylvania.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved:

Section 1. That the Council/~~Board of Commissioners/Board of Supervisors~~ of the ~~City/Borough/Township~~ of GOLDSBORO concurs in Resolution dated September 11, 1985 of the Board of Commissioners of the County of York and hereby approves the designation of York County Industrial Development Corporation as the Industrial Development Agency to represent the County of York in all matters relevant to and for all purposes of the Industrial Development Assistance Law.
