RESOLUTION 2-88

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RENOVATIONS TO THE GYMNASIUM IN THE BOROUGH BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Borough, through the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs, obtained funds for a project involving the renovation of a gymnasium located in the Borough Building of Goldsboro Borough (hereinafter "the Project"), and

WHEREAS, such renovations have been completed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GOLDSBORO BOROUGH, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME, as follows:

1. The Project was completed in accordance with the Grant Agreement between the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs and Goldsboro Borough, and the Project is acceptable to Goldsboro Borough as completed.

2. All expenditures made for the Project have been made and were made in accordance with the aforesaid Grant Agreement.

3. Goldsboro Borough shall maintain the Project in good repair and in an acceptable manner.

4. Goldsboro Borough shall not discriminate the use of the site or the facility in any manner.

5. Goldsboro Borough shall not convert the site or facility to a non-public park, recreation, or community center, without first receiving express written approval from the

Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs.

6. The appropriate officials of Goldsboro Borough are hereby directed and authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the Project with the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs.

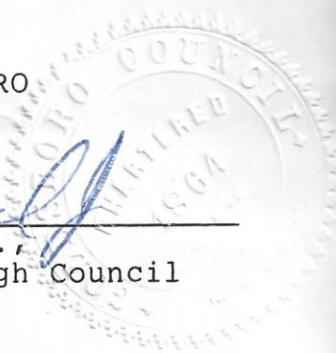
