

RESOLUTION 1989-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MIDDLE DEPARTMENT INSPECTION AGENCY, INC. FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INSPECTION SYSTEM PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CABO ONE AND TWO FAMILY CODE.

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of January, 1989, by Ordinance No. 1989-1 Goldsboro Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, adopted the CABO One and Two Family Code; and

WHEREAS, provisions should be made for the establishment of an inspection system for installations pursuant to said CABO One and Two Family Code; and

WHEREAS, the Middle Department Inspection Agency, Inc., is qualified to make the necessary inspections in accordance with CABO One and Two Family Code, and has consented to make such inspections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY Goldsboro Borough, York County, Pennsylvania that:

1. The proper Borough officials are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with the Middle Department Inspection Agency, Inc. for the establishment of an inspection system pursuant to the adopted CABO One and Two Family Code.

2. Such inspections system shall include provisions for the maintenance of accurate records of all inspections made

by the Middle Department Inspection Agency, Inc.

3. Pursuant to inspection reports submitted by the Middle Department Inspection Agency, Inc., the proper Borough officials are authorized and directed to institute the necessary action to enforce compliance with the adopted CABO One and Two Family Code.

4. The purpose of this resolution is to provide for a competent inspection system of all new installations and the proper Borough officials are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to do any and all things necessary to effectuate such purpose.


5. The penalties as prescribed in Ordinance No. 1989-1 apply to this resolution.




