RESOLUTION NO. 2002-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 461 OF THE LIQUOR CODE, 47 P.S. §4-461.

WHEREAS, CAROLYN DUGAN and JANE HOSTETTLER (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Applicant") have made a request to Goldsboro Borough for the approval of an economic development restaurant liquor license for use at property now or formerly known as the King's Arms Restaurant, Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, §461 of the Liquor Code, 47 P.S. §4-461 requires that the Borough Council, within forty-five (45) days of a request for approval, render a decision by resolution to approve or disapprove the Applicant's request for an economic development license; and

WHEREAS, having given proper public notice, the Goldsboro Borough Council held a public hearing on September 19, 2002, for the purpose of receiving comments and recommendations from interested individuals residing within the municipality concerning the Applicant's intent to acquire an economic development license from the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council, after having heard public comment and recommendations, has determined that the issuance of the economic development restaurant liquor license, as requested by Applicant, would be beneficial to the community and would not adversely effect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality or its residence.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Goldsboro, York County, Pennsylvania, that:

1. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Approval of Economic Development Restaurant License.** After having heard public comments and recommendations, the Borough Council hereby determines that the issuance of the economic development restaurant liquor license to Applicant for use at the property now or formerly known as the King's Arms Restaurant would not be detrimental to or adversely effect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality or its residence, and hereby approves issuance of said liquor license to Applicant by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
