THIS RESOLUTION,; approved and adopted by the Supervisors of Goldsboro Borough, York county, Pennsylvania, on the date hereinafter set forth.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S.), as amended, mandates that Goldsboro Borough prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Borough; and


WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, this Borough has prepared an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, this Borough has also prepared an emergency operations plan in order to reduce the potential affects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Borough;


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Goldsboro Borough do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Radiological Emergency Response Procedures of Goldsboro Borough. This Plan shall be reviewed on an annual basis to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the York County Radiological Emergency Response Procedures.


