RESOLUTION NO. 2016-2**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY WITH RESPECT TO THE CONDITION OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE VICINITY OF WEST BROADWAY AND SECOND AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO AUTHORIZING THE IMMEDIATE REPAIR THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Borough Council that subsurface erosion is occurring beneath the public right-of-way in the vicinity of the intersection of West Broadway and Second Avenue in the Borough of Goldsboro creating a dangerous condition for pedestrians and vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Borough of Goldsboro desires to declare an emergency in order to authorize the Borough to take immediate action to coordinate with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the purpose of remediating and repairing the subsurface erosion and road surface.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council for the Borough of Goldsboro, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, that the Borough of Goldsboro hereby declares and emergency with respect to the subsurface erosion occurring in the vicinity of the intersection of West Broadway and Second Avenue in the Borough of Goldsboro. The Borough Manager is hereby directed to take appropriate steps to coordinate with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, and retaining the services of a competent and qualified contractor, to remediate and repair the dangerous condition resulting from the subsurface erosion. The Borough Manager is specifically directed to coordinate with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation officials to facilitate the remediation and repair of the road.
