RESOLUTION NO. 2017-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF GOLDSBORO, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING THE UPDATED EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN. THE NEW PLAN SUPERCEDES ALL OTHER PLANS.

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 PA. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that Goldsboro Borough prepare, maintain and keep current an Emergency Operation Plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Borough; and

WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, Goldsboro Borough has prepared an updated and revised Emergency Operations Plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Goldsboro approved and adopted a plan under Resolution 2007-1 on February 12, 2007 and would like to replace the preceding plan with this updated/revised plan; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council wishes to adopt and an expanded and updated Emergency Management Plan in order to reduce the potential affects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Goldsboro Borough; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Goldsboro wishes to have the new and expanded/updated Emergency Management Plan supersede all other previous plans;

NOW, THEREFORE, we the undersigned Council of Goldsboro Borough do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Emergency Management Plan of Goldsboro Borough. This plan shall be reviewed every two (2) years to make certain that it conforms to the requirements of the York County Emergency Operations Guidelines.
